
There are more than 36 million adults in the United States that lack basic English literacy skills and basic numeracy skills Only five percent of these adults have access to the education services needed to improve. Low literacy and numeracy skills greatly impact the well-being of these individuals, their families, and their communities.

Low levels of literacy and numeracy are also passed on from one generation to the next. Children of low literate parents have a 72 percent chance of being low literate themselves. These adults are twice as likely to be unemployed, more likely to be incarcerated, and much more likely to struggle with basic life skills like reading a prescription or credit card



THE **SOLUTION?** SMARTPHONES


Adults need a scalable solution that addresses their specific academic needs and is accessible whenever and wherever a learning opportunity arises.

Low Income Dependence

Reliance on smartphones for online access is highest among low-literate and lower-income adults in the US who often have no broadband access or computers at home.




App Design: Keeping Learners Moving! 'Binge Learning'







