

HiSET® Exam at Home

You can continue to achieve your educational goals with the *HiSET*[®] exam at home. The HiSET exam at home is a safe and convenient way to take the same HiSET computer-based test at home. The only difference is the at home option is monitored by a human proctor online through ProctorU[®].

The HiSET exam at home provides the same:

- · test content, format and on-screen experience
- score delivery time (3–5 business days)
- valid, secure and reliable test
- Spanish and testing accommodations

Technical Requirements

If you are 18 years of age or older (or have a valid age waiver), you can take any of the five subtests that make up the HiSET exam on your own computer at home or another secure location. You will need:

- a strong internet connection
- a computer or laptop
- a camera or webcam
- a microphone
- speakers

Schedule an Appointment

You can register online using your My HiSET Account.

- Step 1: In My HiSET Account, choose the remote test center option, select the HiSET subtests and pay for the tests. Pay by debit card, credit card or PayPal[®]. No state vouchers can be used at this time. A \$17.50 test center fee applies for each subtest.
- **Step 2:** After ordering test(s) in My HiSET Account, you complete your registration in your ProctorU account by selecting a test date and time.

Scheduling	Schedule 1–5 tests at a time.
Language options	English and Spanish (per state policies)
Can students combine languages?	Yes (per state policies)
Age requirement	18 years of age or older (or have a valid age waiver)
Are accommodations available?	Yes. Extended time, extra breaks, screen magnification and selectable color accommodations are available.
Practice test requirement	None
Test fee per subtest	\$10.75 (test fees vary; state and other fees may apply)
Test center fee	\$17.50 per subtest
Retest policy	Two free retakes within 12 months of date of purchase. State and test center fees may apply.
Calculator for testing	Embedded in Mathematics subtest; you cannot use your own calculator.
Test scratch paper/note-taking	White dry erase board or a sheet of paper with transparent sheet protector and erasable/ dry erase marker
