We support systems and organizations to leverage technology to increase the reach and impact of education, workforce, & social impact initiatives.

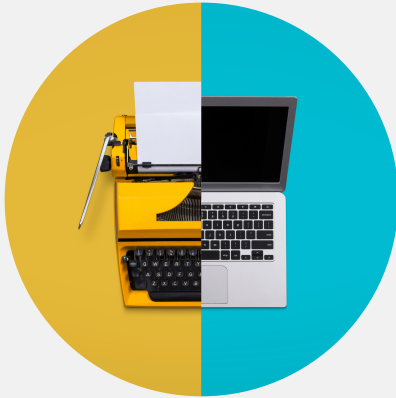


Advancing Digital Equity & Digital Literacy
