WHEREAS, the United States Chamber of Commerce estimates that America currently has 9.8 million job openings. Connecticut, alone has 104,000 according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics; and,

WHEREAS, Adult Education Programs are offered at affordable rates throughout the United States in various settings such as high schools, technical schools and community colleges; and,

WHEREAS, Adult Education Programs are important in the community as these programs present opportunities for our citizens to develop their skill level to prepare them for careers and continuing education; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Cromwell celebrates Adult Education and Family Literacy Week as a proud participant in the National Education & Elevate Campaign to increase awareness of Adult Education Programs and to encourage our citizens to explore options to assist in reaching their professional and personal goals.
