NATIONAL ADULT EDUCATION AND FAMILY LITERACY WEEK

WHEREAS, Baltimore has several adult education programs that empower and support parents and caregivers in improving their educational skills while simultaneously engaging in the educational development of their children; and

WHEREAS, by promoting adult and family literacy, we can ensure that every resident of Baltimore is equipped with crucial literacy, numeracy, and digital skills needed to thrive in everyday life.

THEREFORE, I, Brandon M. Scott, Mayor of the City of Baltimore, do hereby proclaim September 16–21, 2024 as "NATIONAL ADULT EDUCATION AND FAMILY LITERACY WEEK" in Baltimore, and encourage all Baltimore residents to join in this observance.
