WHEREAS, the collaborative efforts of educators, community organizations, and volunteers are instrumental in promoting the value of adult education and family literacy, and in helping to create a more informed and engaged society; and

WHEREAS, the week of September 16-20, 2024 has been designated as Adult Education and Family Literacy Week to recognize the importance of these programs and to celebrate the achievements of learners, educators, and advocates across our state;
